

NOTICE TO CONTRACTORS

Sealed proposals for the Community Development Block Grant FY2009 for Village of Perrysville Standby Generator for Water Treatment Plant, will be received by the Ashland County Commissioners at 110 Cottage Street, Ashland, Ohio until Thursday, September 9, 2010 at 9:20 a.m. Bids will be opened at 110 Cottage Street, Ashland at 9:20 a.m.

Plans, specifications and bid forms may be secured at the Ashland County Planning office at 110 Cottage Street, Ashland, Ohio beginning August 20, 2010. Bidders can request a package to be sent by UPS, at the bidder's expense, by contacting Tim Cooper at (419) 282-4262. The County will not assure responsibility for bids forwarded by mail and no bid will be accepted after specified hours above.

A pre-bid meeting will be held @ 3:30 p.m. on August 26, 2010 at the Perrysville Water Treatment Plant off of Township Road 2826, taking South Bridge Street South before the intersection of County Road 1027, on the Southeast side of the road to Hilltop Drive, Perrysville, Ohio.

Each bid must be accompanied by either a bid bond in an amount of one hundred percent (100%) of the bid amount with a surety satisfactory to the Ashland County Treasurer, or by certified check, cashiers check, or letter of credit upon a solvent bank in the amount of not less than ten percent (10%) of the bid amount in favor of the aforesaid Ashland County Treasurer. Bid bonds shall be accompanied by Proof of Authority of the officials or agent signing the bond. The bid cost of the Perrysville Water Treatment Plant Standby Generator Project is \$62,000. All bids are to be in whole dollars only.

No bidder may withdraw his/her bid within thirty (30) days after the actual date of the opening thereof. Ashland Board of Commissioners reserves the right to reject any or all bids, to waive irregularities in the bidding, and to award the bid on the basis of the lowest and best bidder as it deems to be in the best interest of the County of Ashland, Ohio.
